



WEBSITE ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT FOR ENTITIES REFERRED TO IN ARTICLE 3, PARAGRAPH 1-BIS OF LAW NO. 4 OF 9 JANUARY 2004

Statement

Sesa S.p.A. is committed to making its website accessible in accordance with Law No. 4 of 9 January 2004.

Compliance status: Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the non-compliance issues listed below.

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is not accessible due to non-compliance with Law No. 4 of 9 January 2004:

Web content:

- C.9.1.1.1 – Some non-text content lacks alternative text or contains incorrect or unclear alternative text.
- C.9.1.4.1 – Links or buttons may not be adequately highlighted on mouseover. Text links are identified only by colour.
- C.9.2.1.1, C.9.2.1.3 – Some interactive elements cannot be reached using keyboard navigation. Certain form fields used to filter content lists may be reachable but not properly usable with assistive technologies.
- C.9.2.2.2 – Some decorative videos or animated elements may not provide a mechanism to pause or hide them.
- C.9.2.4.4 – Some links opening in a new window are not identified as such for assistive technologies.
- C.9.3.3.2 – Some form fields used to filter content lists do not have appropriate labels.
- C.9.4.1.2 – Elements with button functionality are not identified as such for assistive technologies. Elements that should not be reachable by screen readers may be exposed, while some that should be reachable are not.

PDF documents:

- C.10.1.1.1 – Some downloadable PDFs may not contain alternative text for non-text elements.
- C.10.1.3.1 – Some downloadable PDFs may not be properly tagged for assistive technologies, may contain tables without correct header-to-data cell associations, or may use fonts that are not embedded in the document.
- C.10.1.4.3 – Some downloadable PDFs may contain insufficient colour contrast between text and background.
- C.10.2.4.2 – Some downloadable PDFs may not have the document title configured in the metadata.
- C.10.3.1.1, C.10.3.1.2 – Some downloadable PDFs may not specify the document language in the metadata. In some PDFs, the language of certain text objects may not be determinable.
- C.10.4.1.1 – Some downloadable PDFs may contain invalid use of elements.



The following content, while not accessible, is neither provided, developed, nor controlled by **Sesa S.p.A.**:

- C.9.3.2.2, C.9.4.1.2 – The cookie management banner provided by a third-party service does not include a submit button and contains button-like elements that are not identified as such for assistive technologies.
- C.9.4.1.2 – The content of an iframe displaying stock market information, provided by a third-party service, may not be fully accessible or usable with assistive technologies.

This content is excluded from accessibility requirements pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 82 of 27 May 2022, Article 1, paragraph 5, letter d.

Equivalent alternative measures:

Where content or functionality is not fully accessible, Sesa S.p.A. has implemented equivalent alternative measures to ensure, as far as possible, access to the information and services provided.

Sesa S.p.A is committed to progressively improving the accessibility of its website and digital services, reducing over time the need to rely on equivalent alternative measures.

Improvement plan

From the date of publication of this statement, the website is subject to an **ongoing improvement plan** aimed at ensuring full compliance with applicable accessibility requirements.

In particular, a progressive review of **web content** and **PDF documents** is underway to address the main issues identified.

Completion of the remediation activities and compliance verification is expected by **30 April 2027**, with periodic interim monitoring to ensure continuous progress.

Drafting of the accessibility statement

This statement was prepared on **09/09/2025**.

The assessment was carried out through a self-evaluation conducted directly by the service provider using objective and subjective analyses (see Article 3(1) of Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2018/1523).

This statement was last reviewed on **30/04/2026**, in accordance with the recommendation to periodically review (at least annually) the accuracy of the information contained in the accessibility statement.
